Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Convicted for Christ is a non-profit corporation, which exists to meet the spiritual needs of our incarcerated brothers with the personal love of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. CFC is unique in that it is made up of Christian prisoners and operates within the prison facilities. This enables us to relate to the unsaved men and women throughout the Department of Corrections.

Two fold Mission:

1. Convert the unsaved to the light of Christ:

We equip our fellow workers within each prison with the tools and training that they need to effectively spread the gospel within their prison.

2. Strengthen their relationship with Christ:

We provide the materials that the workers need to grow in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

We supply our fellow workers with the resources needed to effectively train new disciples.

Our goal is to foster a positive, loving, relationship. We do this by dealing with people on a case-by-case basis. These people have specific needs that must be met, and as Christians, we are to bear each other's burdens and provide for those in need. In order to do this we must first identify their needs. CFC is in the unique position to meet the needs of the hurting and the lost. Our ministry is teaching the inmates to trust and depend on the body of Christ. It also serves to let them know that they are so much more than just a Georgia Department of Corrections number. It teaches them that they are cherished and valued members of the body of Christ. As others who are not saved look on and observe this real tangible love that is found in Christ alone, it will open a door for the gospel to be preached to them. Showing the love to these men and women will help them to begin a new relationship with Christ and strengthen existing ones.

CFC needs to build relationships with our Christian brothers and sisters in society, allowing them to offer sponsorship and ministry partnerships. We will reach outside the prison system to allow others to know the problems and burdens that incarcerated people deal with every second of every day. Some prison ministries work from the outside in, which limits their ministry within the prison. CFC strives to work in the same manner as Jesus does: from the inside out.

CFC provides the following for prisoners with the assistance from sponsors and partners:

- Tracts to reach those in prisons for Christ (designed by CFC)
- Pamphlets on Christian living in prison (designed by CFC)
- Bibles (i.e. KJV, Amplified, NIV, NAS, Study Bibles, Audio Bibles for non readers)
- Bible resources (i.e. dictionaries, concordances, etc.)
- Books on personal/spiritual growth
- Newsletter (published by the prisoners-circulated to prisoners and our sponsors/partners)
- Prisoner sponsorship (pairing prisoners making parole with a church in their hometown)
- Fellowship by mail
- Materials needed by institution churches (in accordance with the institution rules)
- Special needs materials (i.e. reading courses for non-readers and virtual non-readers)

We exist because there is a great need for this type of prison ministry. There is no greater rehabilitation than that provided by Jesus Christ.
